1. GENERAL

The Heiko Fischer Trophy 2026 will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations, the ISU Special Regulations and Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2024 and relevant ISU Communications. (Novice Categories will be held in accordance with ISU Communications 2699 and subsequent updates.) Starting in a lower category than the current season 2025-2026 is not allowed.

Entries: The entry forms provided must be used and sent to:

Deadline for Entries: January 24th 2026

Participation:

1. The organizer withholds the right to cancel categories or to limit the number of competitors, if the number of registrations exceeds capacity.
2. German Clubs: registration must be made exclusively by the respective Landes-Eissportverband. The registration of the participants of German clubs must be made on the provided DEU form, (see appendix). Before registration, validation of the data via the DEU Data Assistant at <http://deu-info.de/datenassistent/excel-validieren> must be completed.

DEU License Fee: German skaters may only participate if the DEU license fee has been paid well before the deadline for entries.

Foreign Clubs: Registration of participants must be made on the provided DEU form (see appendix).

Entry fee:

70,00 € per competitor in Junior and Advanced Novice
45,00 € per competitor in Intermediate / Basic / DEU Novice categories

If no judge is supplied by the association or LEV of the skater, the registration fee per competitor will be **140,00 € / 90,00 €**

In case of late payment, participation will be denied. In case of withdrawal after the deadline of entry, there will be no refunding of the entry fee.

Individual Results:

The marking system (ISU Judging System) will be used in accordance with the respective ISU Communications. The three best-placed skaters in each category will be announced and honored at the official Victory Ceremony. By registering for the competition, the skater agrees resp. the legal representative of the skater agree to the publishing of the results on the internet.

Media/Internet:

Entry lists, results, photos, videos of athletes and livestream of the event will be published on the internet. With Competition Registration, the athlete or the athlete's legal representative agree to the publication of name, results, photos and videos.

Judges:

Participating clubs or LEV are asked to supply one judge per team/ LEV with the minimum qualification "National championships". Hotel costs for judges must be paid by the registering club or association. The organizer withholds the right to choose the panel of judges.

Music:

The music files must be sent as WAV or MP3 file formats by e-mail to musik@eissportverband-bw.de not later than January 24th, 2026 as attachment. Any other format is not acceptable. Links to music files will NOT be accepted. Each submission must be labelled with the name of the ISU Member, name of the category (as written in the Announcement), segment and the name(s) of the competitor(s) **EXACTLY** as follows:

Please note: Files in MP3 format may have a significant difference in the music quality when reproduced. The Organizing Committee in this case is not responsible if the music quality would be insufficient. All competitors must be able to provide back-up copies on CD for each program separately in excellent format on site if requested.

Planned Program Sheet:

The provided ppc Sheets **must** be used and returned in PDF format only.

The ppc must be filled in precisely and labelled with the category (as written in the announcement) and the name of competitor **EXACTLY** as follows:

2. CATEGORIES SINGLES

JUNIOR Women and Men

Age requirements: In accordance with ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2024, Rule 108, paragraph 3

For skaters starting for a German club, the **Kürklasse 2** is required according to the DfBestDKBEK 17.07.2025

Short Program: The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2024, Rule 611, paragraphs 1 and 3 for 2025/26.

Duration: 2:40 min, +/- 10 sec

Free Skating: In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2024, Rule 612 and the respective ISU Communication. Special attention should be paid to the “well balanced program” and the element value.

Duration: 3:30 min, +/- 10 sec

ADVANCED NOVICE Girls and Boys

Age requirements: In accordance with ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2024, Rule 108, paragraph 3 and ISU Communication 2699.

For skaters starting for a German club, the **Kürklasse 3** is required according to the DfBestDKBEK 17.07.2025

Short Program: The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Com. No. 2699, paragraph 2.3. Advanced Novice and subsequent updates.

Duration: 2:20 min, +/-10 sec

Free Skating: Special attention should be paid to the contents of a well-balanced program listed in ISU Communication No. 2699, paragraph 2.3. Advanced Novice and subsequent updates.

Duration: 3:00 min, +/- 10 sec

INTERMEDIATE NOVICE Girls and Boys

Age requirements: In accordance with ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2024, Rule 108, paragraph 3 and ISU Communication 2699.

For skaters starting for a German club, there are **no** Kürklasse requirements.

Free Skating: Special attention should be paid to the contents of a well-balanced program listed in ISU Communication No. 2699, paragraph 2.2.

Intermediate Novice and subsequent updates.

Duration: 3:00 min, +/- 10 sec for girls and boys

BASIC NOVICE Girls and Boys

Age requirements: In accordance with ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2024, Rule 108, paragraph 3 and ISU Communication 2699.

For skaters starting for a German club, there are **no Kürklasse** requirements.

Free Skating: Special attention should be paid to the contents of a well-balanced program listed in ISU Communication No. 2699, paragraph 2.1.
Basic Novice and subsequent updates.

Duration: 2:30 min, +/- 10 sec for girls and boys

DEU PRE-ADVANCED NOVICE (U12) Girls & Boys

The age requirements are in accordance with DfBestDKBEK 17.07.2025:

before the July 1st 2025 the skater has not reached the age of twelve (12)

For skaters starting for a German club, the **Kürklasse 4** is required according to the DfBestDKBEK 17.07.2025.

Free Skating only: Special attention should be paid to the contents of a well-balanced program listed in ISU Communication No. 2699, paragraph **2.3**.
Advanced Novice (including bonus system) and subsequent updates.

Duration: 3:00 min, +/- 10 sec for girls and boys

DEU NOVICE U10 Girls & Boys

The age requirements are in accordance with DfBestDKBEK 17.07.2025:

before the July 1st 2025 the skater has not reached the age of ten (10)

For skaters starting for a German club, the **Kürklasse 6** is required according to the DfBestDKBEK 17.07.2025.

Free Skating: Special attention should be paid to the contents of a well-balanced program listed in ISU Communication No. 2699, paragraph **2.2**.
Intermediate Novice and subsequent updates.

Duration: 3:00 min, +/- 10 sec for girls and boys

DEU NOVICE U8 Girls & Boys

The age requirements are in accordance with DfBestDKBEK 17.07.2025:
before the July 1st 2025 the skater has not reached the age of eight (8)

For skaters starting for a German club, the **Kürklasse 8** is required according to the DfBestDKBEK 17.07.2025.

Free Skating: Special attention should be paid to the contents of a well-balanced program listed in ISU Communication No. 2699, paragraph **2.1**.
Basic Novice and subsequent updates.
In both spins flying entry is not allowed.

Duration: 2:30 min, +/- 10 sec for girls and boys
